

Tips for Flying into Thunder Over Fayette County

We are here to provide you with all the necessary information to ensure your arrival is smooth and stress-free so buckle up and get ready for a great airshow!

Before and during the airshow, temporary restricted areas will be established to ensure the safety of all aircraft and spectators. Please review the NOTAMs (Notice to Airmen) prior to your departure and comply with any restrictions or airspace closures.

Taxiway Alpha will be closed from the Departure end of runway 01 to taxiway Delta. This will allow unrestricted access for pedestrians and vehicles transporting our spectators to the viewing area.

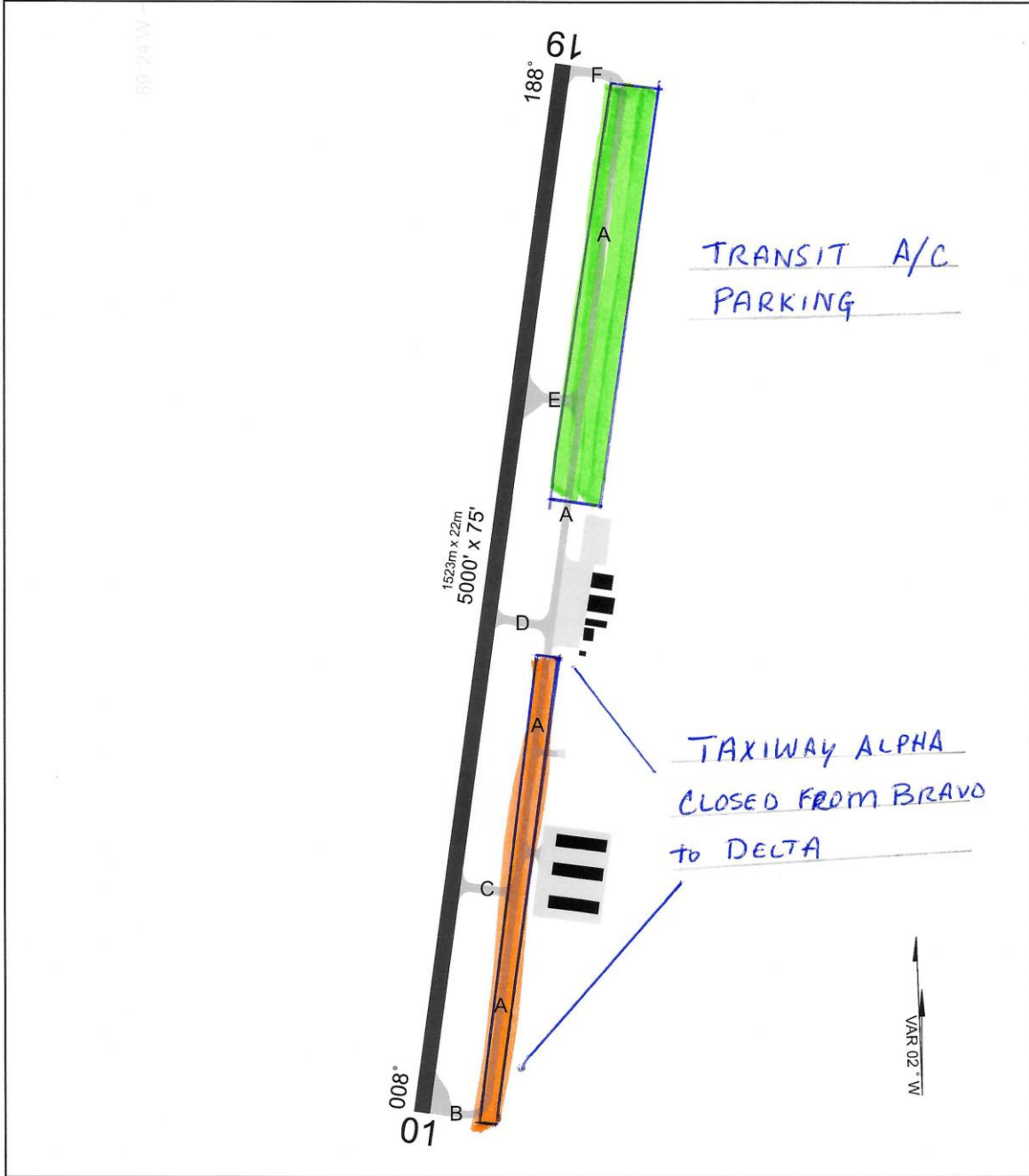
If the active runway is 19, then plan on back-taxing so that you exit on the Echo taxiway. If the active runway is 01, plan on exiting at the Echo taxiway or at the end.

Transit aircraft parking will be accommodated along taxiway Alpha on either side of the asphalt. Please follow your marshaller and don't forget to bring your tie-down stakes. **Only airshow aircraft will be allowed to park on the ramp in front of the terminal.**

If you are flying out after the show, we will **NOT OPEN** the taxiway for departure until **ALL PEDESTRIANS** have cleared the area and wing walkers will be required.

There will be a shuttle service from transit parking to the spectator area.

If you need fuel, please stop by the fuel desk located near the self-serve station, and we will arrange for a fuel truck to come to your airplane.

Event Highlights and Insider Tips:

1. Admission is going to be on the honor system. Either prepay your tickets online or come to the ticket booth near the terminal.
2. Airshow Schedule: Take a few minutes to review the airshow schedule, which can be found on our website. Plan your arrival time accordingly to catch your favorite performances, aerial displays, and ground showcases.
3. Appropriate Attire: Although the airshow is an exciting and casual event, we recommend wearing comfortable clothing and bringing appropriate sun protection, such as hats and sunscreen. Bring a blanket or lawn chair, as well as hearing protection. Coolers are NOT allowed.
4. Spectator Services: Throughout the airshow, various spectator services will be available at the event site, including food vendors, restrooms, information booths, and first aid. Don't hesitate to approach any event staff members wearing identifiable lanyards for assistance.
5. Capture the Moments: The airshow offers endless opportunities for breathtaking photographs and memories. Consider bringing your camera or smartphone to capture the aviation thrills and adrenaline-pumping aerial stunts.
